In Exodus 33:22, God instructs Moses to hide in the cleft of the rock and that as He passes by, He would cover him with His hand. What a comforting thought to know that God's protective hand is always covering us. It is not that we are hiding from danger or not facing what confronts us, but rather we know that we have the comfort and protection of knowing that God is covering us on every path.

The hymn "A Wonderful Savior," (# 508 in our song book) was written by Fanny Crosby who lived from 1820-1915. In her lifetime, she wrote over 8,000 hymns and many of them are still our favorites today. Did you know that our song book contains 19 hymns written by Fanny Crosby? We sing many of them often. *A Wonderful Savior, Blessed Assurance,* and *To God Be the Glory* are just a few of my favorites.

Fanny Crosby was blinded as an infant due to a surgical error. She did not let her blindness prevent her from loving the Lord or sharing her incredible gifts. She spent her entire life teaching and writing hymns and poems. She knew that God was always "covering her with His hand." She has left us a legacy of beautiful hymns that we may continue worshipping our wonderful Savior. I am so thankful to have my soul hidden in the cleft of the rock and knowing that my Lord covers me wherever I go.


